DIRECTOR'S NOTES

The idea came from an experience I had as a person living with disability where I was made to feel very vulnerable in the public space. I felt overwhelmed with fear and distress at the lack of empathy shown. I initially revealed my vulnerability but quickly realised the situation required me to show strength.

It got me asking 'What happens when your usual defences are challenged? Do you stay and fight? What's your fall-back?' It is my response to the feeling of vulnerability – a powerful standing up for oneself.

Drawing on this personal experience Michelle explained in greater detail her thoughts behind creating the work. moments in life that you might take for granted. And if we are lucky, we will have people around us who we trust. Trust is built slowly over time, relinquishing ourselves to the hands of others.

With our backs to the wall, creating edges and boundaries, we build a community around us to keep our fragility protected. It is when we feel dafe enough to let our guards down, we can show the little pieces of ourselves that are our most personal. To be brave, yet vulnerable, is when we feel safe and not exposed.
