Catalysts for Change

- Originally built in 1985
- Whyalla is set to experience significant growth, with expected population of 80,000 by 2040

Vision and Opportunities

- The vision is to be a thriving, welcoming, creative hub where a diverse range of users frequently visit for an equally diverse range of artistic, recreational, social and entertainment activities throughout the day and night
- An updated education, innovation and arts precinct contributes greatly to the enhanced liveability of Whyalla, one of South Australia's most important regional centres

Major Improvements/ Additions Recommended

- New entry, amphitheatre and sculpture courtyard
- Upgraded theatre precinct
- Digital precinct with upgraded cinema auditorium
- New Art Gallery spaces, 250-seat Black Box Theatre and community arts spaces

Cost of Improvements

- Total probable project cost: \$34 million
